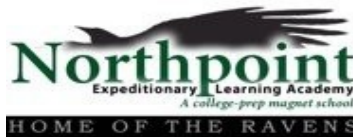
PEOPLE, PLACES AND ACTIVITIES

In February Northland Cares staff visited PFLAG of Sedona to discuss PrEP, PEP, and share information about our free screenings for HIV and Hepatitis C. Northland Cares also gave out safe sex supplies.

In March we teamed up with Yavapai County Community Health Services to participate in an Education Fair at Embry Riddle Aeronautical University. We offered free HIV and Hep C testing and answered questions on PrEP, PEP, STI's, sex positivity and safe sex.
